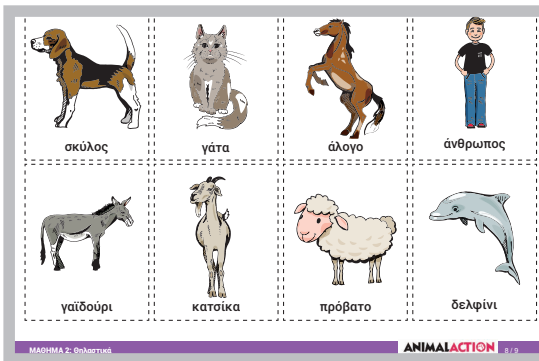


Still fighting for the animals despite Covid-19 chaos!



Like most organisations, we're doing our best to keep our people safe – rescheduling visits and fieldwork and limiting physical contact as much as possible. It's a struggle. The local groups we support are also fighting to go on caring for the animals that need them. Despite the present challenges, we haven't gone away... our vital 'background' work to **change attitudes** continues...

Education ... We've finally achieved a long-held ambition: our first series of specially designed animal welfare lessons for Year 1 of primary school (6-7 year olds) has already been approved by the Greek Ministry of Education! To us this represents

a HUGE STEP because **13 new lesson plans**, which you can see here www.gawf.org.uk/education, are now freely and easily AVAILABLE FOR TEACHERS TO USE IN EVERY STATE PRIMARY IN GREECE! Every child that is taught to respect animals and provide for them responsibly will one day play a part in transforming attitudes. Seen by millions ... at the start of this year our 'public information' short, animated film was broadcast nationally across many TV channels in Greece. Its canine "star" is shown getting up to a whole lot of not-so-polite behaviours, and the 'take-home message' is crystal clear: "Get your dog neutered. He'll be happier, healthier, better behaved, and he won't be responsible for any unwanted litters of puppies!" We know that the humorous content did make the serious message stick and help to change attitudes. Lobbying too, continues unabated. We don't only focus individual cases, we also actively lobby to change the lives of all animals in Greece! That means we speak up for the millions of farm animals that endure dreadful lives, caged in barbaric mass production systems. We are still playing an active part in the ongoing Europe-wide campaign coordinated by Compassion In World Farming (CIWF) and keeping up the pressure on the Greek government to 'end the cage age'. It's cheaper to raise laying hens and farrowing sows in cages. Producers are fighting every step of the way to keep using their current methods, and they're noisily lobbying governments to bring in changes only very gradually or not at all!

Shall we let them get away with forcing animals to lead miserable lives? To break open the cages we absolutely must keep up the pressure! Will you help?
